

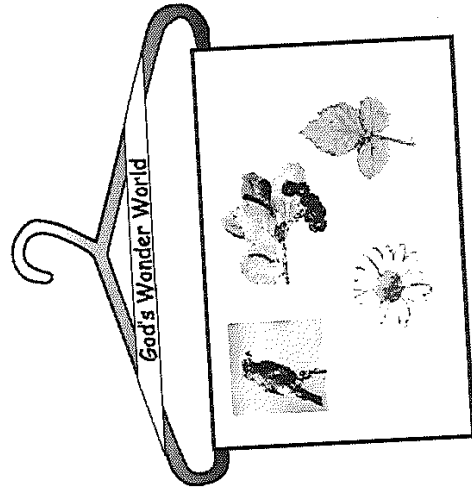
# CREATE

## Creation Wall Hanger

**You will need** a bright plastic clothes hanger, two 23 cm/9 in squares of clear adhesive paper, masking tape, paper, marker, twigs, grasses, leaves, flower petals, and other small items from nature; catalogue pictures of plants.

### Instructions

1. Ask a grownup to help you remove the protective sheet from one piece of adhesive paper and wrap a sticky edge around the bottom bar of the hanger.
2. Tape the hanger and paper to the table to hold it firm.
3. Choose and place nature items and pictures on the adhesive paper.
4. Cover the completed collage with a second piece of adhesive paper (sticky side down).
5. Tape a paper strip saying, "God's Wonder World" across the hanger.
6. Hang your creation at home.
